## What's Going On?

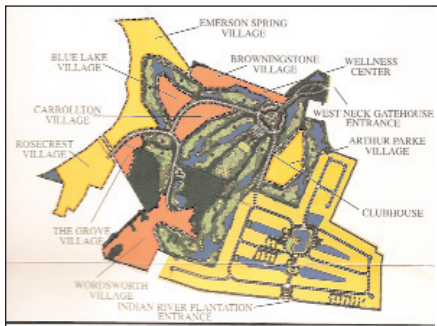

### “WEST NECK HEALTH FAIR”

**October 11, 2011**

Start the morning of the WN Health Fair with a Power Walk, Senior Stretch or Stroll from 8:00 - 9:30 a.m. Then join us for a continental breakfast. The Health Fair is from 10:00 - 12:00 p.m. At 1:00 Tina Erwin will be our guest speaker on healing grief. Events are at the Village Hall. Sentara Hospital (*including flu shots*), the Lions Club and many health-related representatives will be at the fair. **Power Walk:** Begin at the Village Hall and continue past all the monuments of WN's villages. Traveling on Legendary, enter into



the condos of Browningstone. Return to Legendary and pass the entrance to Blue Lake. Turning right onto Cadence, you will pass Emerson Spring

and reach Rosecrest. Returning on Cadence, you will pass The Grove and continue to Wordsworth. Turn right onto Legendary and pass Carrollton. Continue around the circle, bearing right to Arthur Park and return to the Village Hall. (3 mi.) **Senior Stretch:** Leaving the VH, travel down Legendary and turn right onto Cadence. Pass the entrance to ES and continue to Rosecrest. Circle the monument and pass The Grove. Turn right onto Legendary again and pass Carrollton and return to the Village Hall. (2 mi.)

**Senior Stroll:** Begin at the Village Hall, travel down Legendary and pass Browningstone and Blue Lake on your right. At the end of Legendary, return to the VH and pass Carrollton on your right. (1 mi.) **To register, please call the Village Hall at 689-4189. Cyclists and pets are welcome.**
